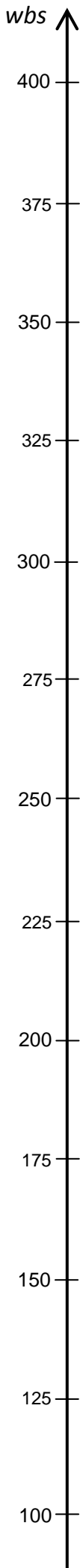


# Community partnerships
