

Intermediate-Secondary Student Survey

This survey will help your teachers understand how students feel about school. Over the page are some questions. You need to colour in one circle to show your answer to each question.

There are two sets of questions.

1. The first set ask how much you **agree or disagree** with a sentence. You can choose “Strongly disagree”, “Disagree”, “Agree”, or “Strongly agree”.

Here is an example.
